# Finn Gold Cup 2019 Notice to Competitors - Medal Race Amendment to Sailing Instructions

The following changes in NoR and SI apply to the Medal Race on Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> December 2019

# SI 12.2 is replaced with:

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located in:

- a) the RBYC dinghy park or,
- b) the RC start vessel, after Delta is displayed.

# Add SI 12.6:

[DP] Flag D displayed ashore with one sound means: 'the warning signal will be made not less than 45 minutes after flag D is displayed.' Boats shall not leave the shore until this signal is made.

Boats leaving the shore before D flag is displayed may be given a one point scoring penalty without a hearing. This changes RRS 63.1 and A5.

#### Add SI 15.14

An umpire signal: Flag X-Ray with one long sound means a boat has been scored OCS or BFD by the Race Committee. The identified boat shall promptly leave the course area. This signal may be given any time from 2 minutes after the starting signal

# Add SI 17.5 [DP][NP] Equipment Inspection Area (EIA)

- 17.5.1 Boats shall be available for inspection in the EIA at the time stated in the race schedule for Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> December 2019.
- 17.5.2 Competitors shall be in the EIA from the time stated in the daily schedule, unless released by the technical committee.
- 17.5.3 A penalty given under this SI shall not be grounds for a boat to request redress. This changes RRS 60.1(b).
- 17.5.4 The EIA shown in the diagram below.
- 17.5.5 Following the medal race, on returning to the shore, competitors shall be available for interviews.
- 17.5.6 Boats or competitors arriving late to the EIA may be given a one point scoring penalty without a hearing. This changes RRS 63.1 and A5.



# SI 20.9:

- 20.9.1 Support and spectator boats shall remain 50 meters outside the race areas at all times.
- 20.9.2 Support and spectator boats shall not be positioned to windward of the centre of the course while boats are racing.
- 20.9.3 If Course LAR2 is signalled, the restricted area extends 50 meters to leeward and on either side of the finishing line.



For the purpose of this SI, Finns not assigned to the medal race are spectator boats.

TV boats and other media boats are classified as Press Boats.
