### 1 Schedule of Racing

- 1.1 Racing will normally be back to back with a total of 7 races scheduled and a target maximum of 3 races on any one day.
- 1.2 No warning signal will be made after 1500hrs on the last day of racing.

### 2 Location of Race Office and Flagpole

- 2.1 The Race Office is in the RBYC Sailing Office.
- 2.2 Signals ashore will be displayed on the flagpole in the RBYC rigging yard.
- 2.3 The official notice board located at <https://sailingresults.net/sa/notice/?ID=81536>
- 2.4 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes'.

### 3 Time Limits

- 3.1 The first boat Race Time Limit is 60 minutes.
- 3.2 The Finishing Window time limit is 20 minutes. The race committee may allocate places based on a boat's position on the course when the Finishing Window has expired. The decision of the race committee is final. This changes RRS 35 and A4.

### 4 Safety Regulations:

- 4.1 For each race session each boat intending to race shall "sign on" via mobile phone before departing the beach and shall "sign off" via mobile phone upon their return after racing.
- 4.2 Failure to sign on prior to racing or off prior to protest cut-off time will result in a 3- point penalty for the first race of the day. This changes RRS A4.
- 4.3 Competitors will receive a text message at registration with a link to the sign on app.
- 4.4 The Sailing Office can sign on/off competitors who are unable to use a mobile phone.

### 5 Replacement of Crew or Equipment:

- 5.1 Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless authorised by the RC. Requests for substitution shall be made to the committee at the first reasonable opportunity.

## Appendix A – Class Flags, Courses, Marks

Marks 1,2,3 are to be left to port.

The Finish line shall be an obstruction except when starting or finishing.
