### 1 Schedule of Racing

- 1.1 Nine races are scheduled, plus two invitation races.
- 1.2 No more than three races will be run on any one day. OA may change this if the weather is not suitable on a particular race day.
- 1.3 Races may be brought forward in the series provided that the sailing program becomes no more than one race ahead of the schedule.
- 1.4 No warning signal will be made after 1500hrs on the last day of racing.

### 2 Location of Race Office and Flagpole

- 2.1 The Race Office is located in the RBYC Sailing Office.
- 2.2 Signals ashore will be displayed on the flagpole in the RBYC rigging yard.
- 2.3 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes'.

#### 3 Time Limits

- 3.1 The first boat Race Time Limit is 60 minutes.
- 3.2 The Finishing Window time limit is 20 minutes. The race committee may allocate places based on a boat's position on the course when the Finishing Window has expired. The decision of the race committee is final. This changes RRS 35 and A4.

#### 4 Protests and Requests for Redress

- 4.1 Appendix T (Arbitration) will apply.
- 4.2 A team manager is permitted to attend arbitration to support a young competitor.
- 4.3 Any assistance and advocacy regarding protests, or requests for redress, is to be provided by the team manager only.

## 5 Safety Regulations:

- 5.1 For each race session each boat intending to race shall sign on at the regatta office before departing the beach and shall sign off upon their return after racing.
- 5.2 Failure to sign on prior to racing or off before protest cut-off time will result in a 3-3-point penalty for the first race of the day. This changes RRS A4.
- 5.3 Competitors will receive a text message at registration with a link to the sign-on app.

## Appendix A – Class Flags, Courses, Marks

Marks 1,2,3 are to be left to port.

The Finish line shall be an obstruction except when starting or finishing.
