## **Getting to RBYC**

RBYC is located at 253 Esplanade, Middle Brighton, Victoria 3186 adjacent to the Brighton Sea Baths and Middle Brighton Pier. The nearest cross street is Grosvenor Street. Enter via the entrance immediately to the south of the Sea Baths.

All boats will be stored on the hard stand in secured areas at RBYC for the duration of the event. Upon arrival at the Club you will require a key to access the pier to drive your boat to the hardstand. Keys are available from reception. Entry to the pier is via a mixed bike and pedestrian path, so please take care when both entering and traversing the pier. Please turn on your hazard lights. There is no vehicle entry directly from the Esplanade.

## **Registration**

Registration and weighing is on Saturday 0900 – 1700 and Sunday 0900 - 1200.

## **Car Parking**

Paid parking with a 4 hour limit is available in the Council Car Park to the south of the club. Free parking is available on Beach Road, Grosvenor Street (1 side of street only) and other nearby side streets – ensure you observe the signs. Also be aware that there is a length limit on parking. If your trailer is attached to your car, it will be over the limit but if it is unhitched will be within limits.

## **Boat and trailer storage arrangements**

All boats will be stored in secured areas at RBYC on the hardstand for the duration of the event. Upon arrival at the Club you will be advised by a marshal as to where your boat is to be stored.

## **Competing Boats arrival and drop off times**

Competing boats may be dropped off at RBYC:

- From 9am Friday 12<sup>th</sup> January.
- From 9am Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> January.
- At other times by appointment – call the RBYC Sailing Office on 9592 3092.
