Notice of Race V2

JA Linacre Trophy for the Jubilee Victorian Championships 24-25 February 2024

The Organising Authority (OA) is Sorrento Sailing Couta Boat Club (SSCBC), in conjunction with the Jubilee Yacht Association of Australia (JYAA)

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) including the Special Regulations Part 2.
- RRS 40.1 (Personal Flotation Devices) applies at all times afloat. 1.2
- 1.3 Appendix T will apply.
- The Post Race Penalty in T1 (b) is changed to increase a boat's score by 25% of the difference between 1.4 her score without the penalty and the score for retirement.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

3 COMMUNICATIONS

- 3.1 The online official notice board (ONB) is located at https://sailingresults.net/sa/notice/?ID=81713
- Regatta Information will be pushed out on this WhatsApp group Scan or click this 3.2 QR.
- 3.3 [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY 4

- 4.1 Jubilees that comply with the class regulations may enter online using the online entry link.
- 4.2 Each skipper and nominal crew shall be a member of the JYAA.
- 4.3 The Entry fee is \$150 before midnight 12 Feb and \$225 after that.

- 5.1 Registration can be completed at the sailing office during business hours on Friday or from 0930 on Saturday.
- 5.2 No warning signal will be made after 1600 hrs on the last scheduled day of racing.

6 [DP] EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

Boats and equipment may be subject to inspection at any time during the regatta to ensure compliance with the Rules.

7 VENUE

Racing will be conducted on the waters of Port Phillip in the vicinity of SSCBC.

8 THE COURSES

Laid Triangle and Windward Leeward courses – If the Couta Boat State Championships use the resail provision on Saturday 24th They will race on the same course.

9 SCORING

- 9.1 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.2 A maximum of 5 races will be sailed.
- 9.3 When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 9.4 When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores, excluding her worst score.

10 CODE OF CONDUCT

10.1 [DP] Competitors and support persons shall comply with reasonable requests from race officials and SSCBC Staff.

11 BERTHING

- 11.1 [NP] Boats and support vessels shall be kept in their assigned places during the event. Boats and trailers may be relocated at the discretion of the organising authority.
- 11.2 [SP] Trailers are normally kept at competitors' accommodation and shall not be kept at the club or the lower or upper car parks or their vicinity. Trailers may be stored at the Wooden Boat Shop.

12 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded for the first three placed boats.

13 INSURANCE

Each boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of AUD \$5 Million (recommended \$10,000,000) per incident or equivalent.
