NOTICE OF RACE

The International Finn 2025 South Australian Championship will be conducted by the Adelaide Sailing Club in conjunction with the International Finn Association of Australia, on 01 and 02 November 2025.

1 Rules

- 1.1 The International Finn 2025 South Australian Championship will be governed by the rules as defined in the current *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS)
- 1.2 Australian Sailing Prescriptions and Special Regulations Part 2 shall apply.
- 1.3 Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns penalty is replaced with a One-Turn penalty.
- 1.4 The International Finn Association class rules shall apply.
- 1.5 RRS Appendix P5.2(a) and P5.3(b) (O and R Flags) shall apply.
- 1.6 Bow numbers are optional but encouraged. Bow numbers must match the sail number.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 The Championship is open to boats of the International Finn Class.
- 2.2 Competitors must be financial members of the International Finn Association of Australia and of a club affiliated with Australian Sailing.
- 2.3 Entry is via the Entry Link which is available on the Online Notice Board for this event.

3 Fees

3.1 The entry fee is \$100 per boat.

4 Schedule

| Sunday 02 November | After Sailing | Presentation at ASC |

- 4.1 It is intended to conduct three races on each day for a maximum of six races.
- 4.2 Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 4.3 No warning signal will be made after 15:00 on Sunday 02 November 2025.

5 Courses

- 5.1 Courses will be windward-leeward and as described in the Sailing Instructions.
- 5.2 Target race time is 40 minutes.

6 Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of AUD\$10,000,000.

7 Sailing Instructions

7.1 Sailing Instructions will be available at the <u>event website</u> prior to the Commencement of the Championships.

8 Prizes

- 8.1 The winner of the Championship shall be awarded the South Australian Finn Championship Perpetual Trophy.
- 8.2. Other prizes may be awarded.
