

NOTICE OF RACE

2025/26 International Cadet Class of SA South Australian State Championship



ORGANISING AUTHORITY

International Cadet Class of South Australia

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2025-28.
- 1.2. The Class Rules of the International Cadet Class are available on the International Cadet Class Association website (www.cadetclass.org).
- 1.3. The Australian Sailing (AS) prescriptions and special regulations Part 2 for Off the Beach Boats shall apply.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority (OA).

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1. The regatta is open to boats of the International Cadet Class.
- 3.2. Competitors must be aged 17 years or under on 31 December 2025. Proof of age may be required.
- 3.3. Competitors must be current members of their State Class Association. Registrations can be completed here: <https://www.revolutionise.com.au/iccasa/registration/>
- 3.4. All entrants will be members of a yacht club affiliated with a Member Yachting Association of Australian Sailing.
- 3.5. Eligible boats must submit entries via the [website](#) together with payment of the required entry fee.

4. FEES

- 4.1. The entry fee for Leg 1 held at the Adelaide Sailing Club is \$100 for each competing boat.
- 4.2. Entry fee for Leg 2 held at the Pt Lincoln Yacht Club to be confirmed once entries for this leg are opened.

5. SCHEDULE

- 5.1. Eleven (11) championship races are scheduled.
- 5.2. No warning signal will be made after 1500 on the last scheduled day of racing of each weekend.
- 5.3. Schedule of racing:

6. EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 6.1. Each boat shall hold of be able to verify the existence of a valid measurement certificate, which may be sighted by the event measurer at any time.
- 6.2. Sails must be measured and initialled by the respective State Measurer.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 7.1. The sailing instructions will be available on the [International Cadet State Championship 2025-26](#)

8. VENUE

- 8.1. Leg 1 – Adelaide Sailing Club (6th/7th December 2025)
- 8.2. Leg 2 – Port Lincoln Yacht Club (TBA 2026)

9. THE COURSES

- 9.1. The course to be sailed will be trapezoid or windward leeward. The courses will be as described in the sailing instructions.

10. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 10.1. Appendix P, Immediate Penalties for Breaking Rule 42, as modified so that P2.3 is deleted and P2.2 shall apply to second and subsequent infringements of Rule 42, shall apply to this regatta.

11. SCORING

- 11.1. Five (5) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.2. When six (6) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 11.3. When seven (7) to nine (9) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 11.4. When ten (10) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two (2) worst scores.

12. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

- 12.1. In participating in the Event, a competitor automatically grants to the OA and the sponsors of the Event the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show from time to time and at their discretion any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or film or television or other reproductions of him/her during the period of competition for the said event in which the competitor participates and, in all material, related to the said Event without compensation.

13. PRIZES

- 13.1. Prizes will be given as follows:
- State Champion positions 1-3
 - State Handicap positions 1-3
 - Bob Turner – most improved 1st year Skipper
 - Christen Flaherty – Captain of State Team
 - JA Christopherson – most improved crew
 - The Penrose Trophy – first female
 - Hughes/Parslow – Best performance by a new skipper at States
 - Shield – interclub trophy

14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 14.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 3, Decision to Race.
- 14.2. The OA and host club will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to or during or after the regatta.

15. SAFETY

- 15.1. Inflatable lifejackets are not permitted. This changes International Cadet Class Rules C.3.1.(b).
- 15.2. Attention is drawn to Rule 1.2 and Rule 3.
- 15.3. Sign On and Sign Off [NP] [DP]
Boats shall Sign On prior to leaving shore and boats returning to shore shall Sign Off. When races are sailed back to back, competitors need only Sign On and Sign Off on shore once.
Boats retiring or leaving the course for any reason shall inform the Race Committee Boat either in person, or via a safety or coach boat at the earliest possible opportunity.

16. INSURANCE

- 16.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5 million (\$10 million recommended) per incident or the equivalent. All owners/competitors who complete the Entry Registration are deemed to have made a declaration that they hold such cover.

17. AMENDMENTS

- 17.1. Any amendment to this Notice of Race will be posted on International Cadet State Championship 2025-26 and the event website.
