Notice of Race (NoR)

The Organising Authority (OA) is Fremantle Sailing Club (FSC) in association with the OK Dinghy Association of WA.

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1.

1. RULES

1.1. The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1. The event is open to all boats of the OK Dinghy class.
- 4.2. Boats may enter the event by registering online via the registration.

6. SCHEDULE

Racing will be conducted within the Fremantle Dinghy racing program for 7 March and 28 March 2026 with an additional 3rd race added for OK Dinghies

7. EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

- 7.1. Boats shall comply with RRS 78. Each boat shall produce or verify the existence of a valid measurement certificate.
- 7.2. Boats may be subject to an equipment inspection at any time during the event.

8. SCORING

- 8.1. Scoring will be the Low Point System.
- 8.2. 2 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 8.3. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
