1 RULES

The event is governed by the *rules* as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

The Australian Sailing (AS) Special Regulations Part 2- Off the Beach Classes and AS Prescriptions will apply.

[DP] Competitors and support persons shall comply with any reasonable request from an event official.

[DP] Denotes a rule for which the penalty is at the discretion of the protest committee.

[SP] Denotes a rule for which a standard penalty may be applied by the Race Committee or Technical Committee without a hearing. This changes RRS 63.1 and A5.

[NP] Denotes that a breach of this rule will not be grounds for protest by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

All competitors shall be members of a club affiliated with Australian Sailing and financial members of the Tasmanian Flying 11 Class Association.

All entries for the series shall be via the online entry accompanied by the prescribed fee and be lodged with the Organising Authority by 1600 hours on Wednesday 18 March 2026.

3 ENTRY FEES

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available on the RYCT/OTB website from 1600 Friday 20 March 2026.

5 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS/SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located at the OTB Centre. Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flag mast at the OTB Centre.

6 SCHEDULE OF RACES

- Event Registration Saturday 21st March 2026 Time 11.15 TO 11.45AM
- Championship Races Saturday 21 March 2026 First Warning Signal 13:00
- Championship Races Sunday 22 March 2026 First Warning Signal 13:00
- No warning signal will be made after 16:00 on Sunday 22 March 2026.
- There will be no more than 5 races each day.

7 RACING AREA

The racing area will be the Derwent River between Battery Point and Long Point.

8 COURSES

The courses will be as described in the Sailing Instructions.

9 SCORING

- There will be a maximum of 8 races. A minimum of six races will constitute a series.
- If fewer than six races are completed a boat's score will be the total of her series scores.
- If six or more races are completed a boat's score will be the total of her series scores excluding her worst score.

10 PRIZES

The winners of this series will be inscribed on the Tasmanian Flying 11 Champions trophy.

For each race held the prizes will be the following

Scratch	Handicap
1 st - \$70*	1 st - \$70*
2 nd - \$35*	2 nd - \$35*
3 rd - \$20*	3 rd - \$20*

* If 3 or less boats compete in the states 1st prize will only be awarded. If 4 boats compete in the states 1st and 2nd prizes will only be awarded. If 5 or more boats compete in the states 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes will be awarded

11 ENTRY DISCLAIMER

It is the competitor's decision to enter an event or to start and continue in any race. Attention is drawn to RRS 3 Decision to Race. Competitors shall accept that their participation in an event is at their exclusive risk in every respect. By way of entry in the Event competitors shall indemnify the Organising Authority, the host sailing club, their officers, members, servants and agents in respect to all claims and demands of whatever nature which may be made upon them in connection with or howsoever arising from their participation or intended participation in the event.

The Organising Authority, the host sailing club, their officers, members, servants and agents accept no responsibility in respect of loss of life, personal injury or loss or damage to property which may be sustained by reason of their participation or intended participation in the event or howsoever arising in connection with the event.

12 Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5,000,000. Confirmation to be provided at registration.
